# TRANSIT 60

## 1965 Transit Mk1

The beginning of an era, with the first Ford Transit produced on August 9. Updated in 1975 with a new 'black look', the one millionth Ford Transit was soon driven off the assembly line.



## 1986 Transit Mk3

A revolutionary new "fast front" design gave the Transit Mk3 a best-in-class drag coefficient (Cd) of 0.37; better than many cars at the time. Updated in 1994, recognisable by its friendly oval shaped grille, it was the most refined, secure and safe Transit to that point.



## 2006 Transit Mk5

A fresh exterior design, a new cabin offering dash-mounted gear lever and the introduction of Intelligent All-Wheel Drive, it was enough to win the "International Van of the Year" accolade again in 2007.



## 2012 Transit Custom

Introduction of the new one-tonne Transit Custom as part of a coming all-new four model line-up with all-new two-tonne Transit, all-new Transit Connect and the all-new Transit Courier.



## 1978 Transit Mk2

Based on the popular Mk1, but with more space under the bonnet for both petrol and increasingly popular diesel engines. The 2.5-litre DI diesel engine is introduced offering fuel consumption improvements of up to 24 per cent. Two millionth Ford Transit is produced.



## 2000 Transit Mk4

Voted "International Van of the Year" in 2001, the Transit Mk4 offered an industry first, with front-wheel drive

and rear-wheel drive configurations built on a common platform. Ford's new common-rail diesel engine, the Duratorq TDCi, was also introduced.



## 2024 E-Transit Custom

The second all-electric Transit is launched, the E-Transit Custom, meeting the needs of small and medium businesses looking to electrify, supported by Ford Pro services. Includes an official MS-RT E-Transit Custom version, the most powerful Transit Custom to-date.



## 2023 Mk2 Transit Custom

The first Transit Custom on a next-generation platform is launched, delivering enhanced load carrying, improved driver comfort and convenience, plus a range of high-efficiency powertrain options. Named "International Van of the Year" in 2024.



## 2022 E-Transit

The launch of the first fully electric full-size Transit, the E-Transit marks a new chapter in Ford commercial vehicles, with Ford Pro launching the same year to provide fully integrated, digital-first solutions to help customers manage their fleets.



## 2014 Mk6 Transit

The flagship of the renewed and expanded Transit range, the all-new two-tonne Transit is launched. It's developed for sale in six continents including Europe and North America. In Europe, production extends to every available bodystyle and variant to give customers the ultimate choice.
